We put the Chinese version of the Taiwan's National Report onto AEC's website two days ago.

So, in view of the openness and transparency, AEC suggest EC to extend the effective date of ENSREG website for collecting public consultation for one month, i.e., from July 5 to August 5.

AEC will surely be responsible for addressing any question provided in Chinese.

Here I would reply some questions from your previous mails dated June 23 and 25 as follows:

1. The Reference Date of Taiwan's National Report was June 30, 2011, as all the European plants did.
2. We did thoroughly follow the ENSREG specification to prepare the Taiwanese National Report though there may be no clear statement in our report.

We are planning to have additional chapter (i.e. Chapter 0) describing relevant information in one month. It will be sent to you when completed.

3. For the Checklist on the basis of "Compilation of Recommendations and suggestions – Peer review of stress tests performed on European nuclear power plants" to cover all the

implementation status of Post-Fukushima improvements in Taiwan's nuclear power plants, please allow us one month to prepare it, because there have been huge amount of information to tackle with.

4. For the hazard of volcano, we have asked TPC to provide information following the IAEA No. NS-G-1.5 Safety Guide.
5. We have received first round questions for all three Topics from ENSREG experts, and we're trying to have the complete answers within one month.
